





NATIONAL INFODAYS

The Info-day was on 23.10.2024 in Blagoevgrad, Bulgaria (Struma Catchment). The event was organised by the Faculty of Ecology and Environmental protection of the University of Forestry, the Lead partner of the Wetland4Change thematic project.

We brought together representatives from municipalities, the River Basin Management Directorate, regional authorities, and South-West University Neofit Rilski to explore the vital role of wetlands in tackling climate change, as well as explain how thematic project implements Nature-based Solutions (NbS) and promotes sustainable management practices.

During the meeting, we informed the participants about the main objectives of the thematic project and the expected results. These include the development of innovative approaches and practices for wetland conservation and their role in sustainable natural resource management and climate risk mitigation. We discussed how local stakeholders can actively participate in the project implementation and how the results can support local climate change adaptation efforts.

We introduced the participants to the nature and work of the Natural Heritage Mission, as well as this year's awareness campaign on 'Ecosystem Restoration'.
