Key Message

The Natural Heritage Mission is an opportunity to liaise and network; exchange experiences and resources; and increase the organisations' influence on policy making.

Main outcomes

The Mission's 1st Institutional Dialogue event engaged both the Projects' Partners (PPs) and Associated Partners (APs) of the two Governance Projects: Community4Nature and Dialogue4Nature.

The Community Building exercise -within the above event- favoured quick exchanges between participants on 3 topics:

Q1 - Define how your expertise links with Natural Heritage.

Q2 - What opportunities can the Mission for Natural Heritage provide you?

Q3 - Project, solution, experience you want to share.

After answering the 3 topics on an "ID card", all cards were put together and the participants one after the other picked randomly an "ID card" from the pile and asked the person having signed the card to go deeper in one of the 3 topics.

Remarks

During the exercise, the participants were divided to 5 groups per kind of organisation (i.e. Public Sector, Higher Education and Research, NGOs/Agencies/SMEs) in order to have a more interactive result.

The community presents a big diversity, with people from very different backgrounds (from cave microbiologists and insect ecologists to mechanical, chemical and agronomic engineers, database managers, or practitioners and policy-makers).

Next steps

- Integration of the new Thematic Projects (TPs) starting in 2024
- Working Groups' work plan for 2024-2025
- Institutional Dialogue Event for 2024

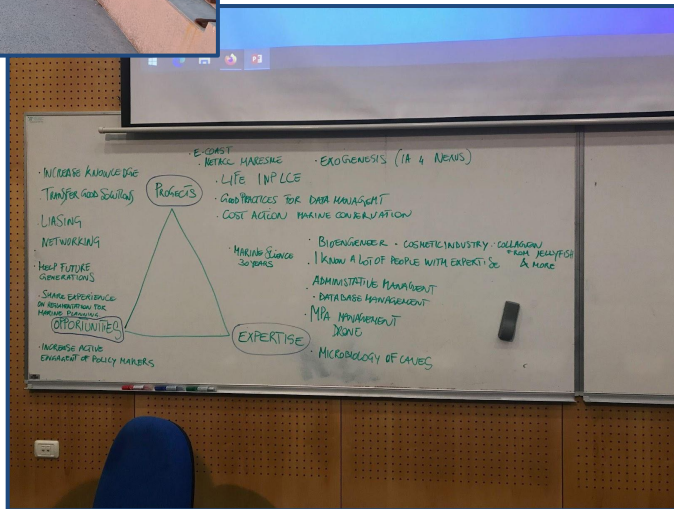
