Developing knowledge based policy, advice and guidance on the full suite of issues surrounding protected areas.




#### Climate Crisis Commission

## What is policy?


# A framework for action selected from among alternatives to guide governance and management:

- Focused at global, trans-national, national or local level;
- Formulated through a set of processes involving the participation of <u>diverse stakeholders</u> who have discussed alternatives and have given input into choices to be made;
- Sanctioned by a legitimate authority, in particular Inter Governmental Organisations, Regional authorities, national, provincial and local government, traditional authorities, influential organisations, or consortia of influential organisations and/or governments.
- Might take the form of treaties, accords and other multilateral processes








# A complex mosaic of policies














## Some examples at the European level
