## Goals & Objectives

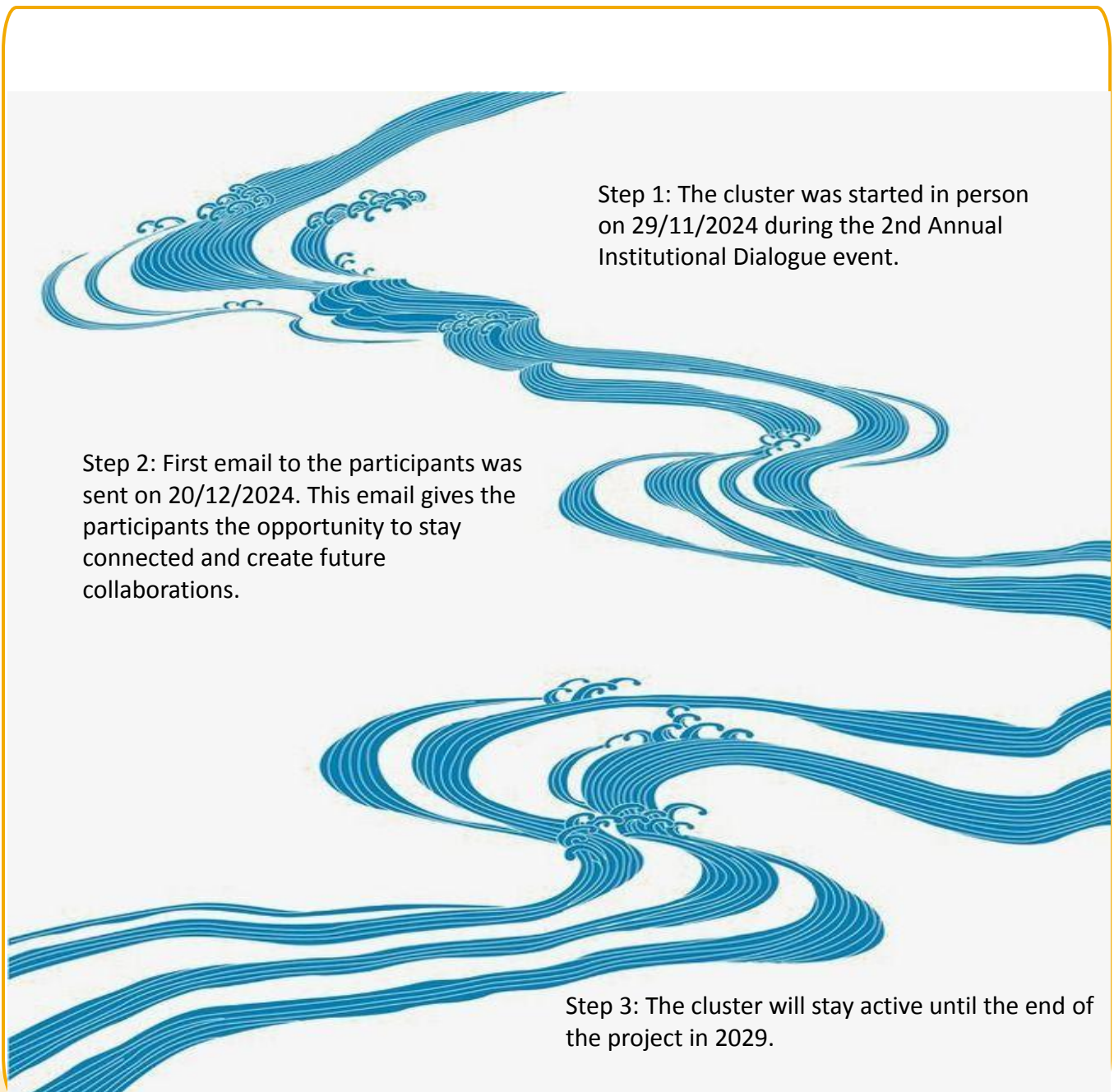
