Mediterranean rural areas are under permanent water stress due to unsustainable practices and overexploitation of water resources, with food and energy sectors responsible for ~90% of total consumption. Redeem aims to enhance the water resilience and ecosystem health of rural areas by:

Demonstrating and transferring nature-based and technological solutions to address water scarcity.
